EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

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| FIRST AID: | <p>Swallowed: If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. For advice, contact the National Poisons Centre on 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor immediately. Begin artificial respiration if the victim is not breathing. Use mouth-to-nose rather than mouth-to-mouth.</p> <p>Eyes: If splashed in eyes, wash out immediately with water. Contact a doctor immediately.</p> <p>Skin: If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water.</p> <p>Inhaled: If inhaled move the victim to fresh air immediately. Begin artificial respiration if breathing has stopped.</p> |
| FIRE: | <p><u>Extinguishing Media:</u> carbon dioxide, dry chemical, foam, water fog. <u>Special Fire fighting procedures:</u> Wear full protective clothing including self contained breathing apparatus. <u>Unusual fire & Explosion hazards:</u> Decomposition products are toxic and corrosive. There is little risk of an explosion from this product if involved in a fire.</p> |
| SPILLAGE: | In case of accidental spillage damp down with sawdust or other absorptive material then sweep up and bury in a safe landfill. Wear protective clothing. Use absorbent material to prevent the spread of the spillage. Block drains if possible. Sweep up contaminated material and place in drums for disposal in a manner acceptable to the appropriate authorities. For major spills, the Fire Service should be informed immediately, followed by local Health Protection Officers. |
| DISPOSAL: | Triple rinse empty container and add rinsate to spray tank. Burn in an appropriate incinerator, if circumstances such as wind direction permit. Otherwise crush and bury in a suitable landfill. Avoid contamination of any water supply with product or empty container. |
