The rates recommended are for high volume spraying to the point of run off. For concentrate spraying adjust dilution rate accordingly.

Crop	Disease	Rates	Remarks
Apples	Black spot	10 ml / 100 litres of water (refer tree row volume guide)	Apply in a protectant programme, during the growing season. From Greentip to the end of November, use at 7-10 day intervals. Use the shorter interval during periods of rapid growth and when heavy infection pressure occurs. The spray interval may be increased to 10-14 days as growth and infection pressure decline after November. Use no more than 4 applications per season. Either apply 2 consecutive sprays of Vista Flo in tank mix with a fungicide from a different cross-resistance group, then alternate with at least 2 applications of fungicides from a different cross-resistance group before applying a further bracket of 2 Vista Flo sprays, or, apply strobilurin-containing fungicides, in tankmix, in strict alternation with an effective non-strobilurin fungicide.
	Powdery mildew	As above	Apply as part of a protectant programme, to mildew sensitive varieties at 7-10 day intervals from Pink to second cover and then as required. Use no more than 4 applications per season. Either apply 2 consecutive sprays of Vista Flo in tank mix with a fungicide from a different cross-resistance group, then alternate with at least 2 applications of fungicides from a different cross-resistance group before applying a further bracket of 2 Vista Flo sprays, or, apply strobilurin-containing fungicides, in tankmix, in strict alternation with an effective non-strobilurin fungicide.

Notes: Complete coverage of all parts of the tree is critical. A spreader-sticker may be used to assist coverage.

Concentrate spraying may be used on the basis that the rate of product applied is equal to the rate that would be applied per hectare with dilute application (refer to tree row volume rate indications).

Rainfall: Vista Flo is rainfast once dried on the tree. Cover sprays should be replaced after 50mm of rainfall or after three or more consecutive days of significant rainfall, e.g. 10-20 mm/day.

Tree Row Volume Rate Guide: Tree row volume is affected by the shape and density of trees. The lower water and product rates are indicated on pyramid shaped trees of moderate to low density. Higher rates are indicated for dense foliage and box shaped trees.

Tree height	Indicated dilute water rate	Rate of Vista Flo per hectare
2 metres	1000-1500 L/ha	100-150ml
3 metres	1500-2000 L/ha	150-200ml
4 metres	2000-2500 L/ha	200-250ml
5 metres	2500-3500 L/ha	250-350ml
